Memorandum of Understanding

between

Belarusian State University of Informatics and Radioelectronics Minsk, Republic of Belarus

and

Meru University of Science and Technology, Meru, Republic of Kenya

Belarusian State University of Informatics and Radioelectronics, represented by Rector Vadim Bogush, acting on the basis of the Charter, on the one part, and Meru University of Science and Technology, represented by Prof. Romanus Odhiambo Otieno the Vice Chancellor, acting on the basis of the Meru University Charter and Statutes on the other part, hereinafter jointly referred to as «the Parties», guided by mutual interest in cooperating in the spheres of education and research, whereas a decision on joint mutually beneficial activities have been taken, whereas the Parties have admitted the viability of academic and scientific cooperation in the spheres of information technologies, electronics, telecommunications, technics, economics, and etc., now therefore the Parties have agreed to conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

Article I

The Parties agree to develop the following collaborative activities:

- 1.1. To encourage exchange of academic, research and administrative staff for experience exchange, lecturing, research, training participation in conferences and other events.
- 1.2. To facilitate exchange of PhD, Master and undergraduate students in order to develop academic mobility.
 - 1.3. To develop scientific cooperation, joint research and consultancy activities.
- 1.4. To contribute to joint educational and research projects, both bilateral and within the framework of international programmes.
 - 1.5. To exchange, jointly prepare and publish educational, methodical and research materials.
 - 1.6. To collaborate in other fields of mutual interest.

Article II

Implementation of cooperation in Article I shall be dealt with on a case-by-case basis. A specific plan should be proposed in written form and discussed between the Parties. The plan should ensure all appropriate arrangements for the payment of expenses involved.

Article III

In an effort to support student and faculty exchanges, research or projects, the Parties will endeavor to provide logistic support, including required facilities and assistance that will allow exchange personnel to pursue their study, research or project interests.

Article IV

In support of this MoU and in an effort to obtain financial support from other sources to further develop mutually beneficial activities, the Parties will work to develop project proposals for submission to funding agencies. In order to work towards the implementation of this, the Parties will agree on a plan of action, including MoU of financial details.

Article V

This MoU shall become effective on the date that it is signed by both Parties, and will be valid for a period of five years with the possibility of its prior termination.

Article VI

The MOU can be changed or revised. All changes and amendments are concluded in written form, and signed by the authorized representatives of the Parties.

Article VII

The MOU may be terminated by either Party at any time provided that the terminating Party gives written notice of its intention at least six months prior to termination. In any case, of discontinuance, the Parties will honour agreed commitments either via the accepted arrangement or suitable alternative negotiated at that point.

Article VIII

The MOU is drawn up in two copies in English language, one copy for each Party, which have the same legal force.
